We encourage submissions on any aspect of Germany's experiences concerning repair and restitution, broadly defined. Of particular interest are papers that draw on newly available primary sources, employ non-traditional methodologies, or highlight perspectives of previously understudied actors.

To apply for the *Graduiertenkolleg*, prospective participants should submit a 300-word abstract and a brief academic CV (in a single PDF document, with the file titled as your surname).
